1. BERNHARD⁴ JOHANSSON (*JOHAN SALOMON³ MAGNUSSON, MAGNUS² HANSSON, HANS¹ HAUSSON*) was born 27 May 1881 in Askome, Sweden, and died 09 April 1964 in Yolo, Woodland, CA.

Notes for BERNHARD JOHANSSON:

From letter to Helene Roth in Sweden from Ellen Kjellman, May 24, 1989

"Bernhard lived in Rhode Island when he came from Sweden, moved to Oregon- Washington and then to California (all on the west coast). As far as I know he never married or had a family. He kept in touch with my father and me but not too often."

From Helene Roth in Sweden by email, 6 Aug 2000

"The vicars were not always so nice when they wrote notes about the members in the parish. As for Bernhard. In the churchbook the vicar has written about Bernhard "very poor ability to comprehend". If it had been possible, I would have liked to write underneath " He wasn't so bad after all. Went to Amerika where the vicar hadn't probably been himself. Went to California and lived there until he was an old man". Not so bad from a person with "poor ability to comprehend!".

From copy of death certificate

It states that Ben had lived in Yolo County for 41 years and a total of 56 years in California at time of death. He was 82 when he died, and died at Yolo General Hospital in Woodland, CA.

It was believed that Ben ran or worked at a trucking company in California.
